

# International Continuing Competence Summit

Held in Conjunction with the 2018 Institute for Credentialing Excellence (ICE) Exchange

## Overall goal of the Summit

To present research and literature supporting various approaches to continuing competency assessment and demonstration and to review novel approaches to recertification/revalidation being undertaken both in the US and abroad.

## Structure

The Institute for Credentialing Excellence (ICE) will host the International Continuing Competence Summit during the pre-conference day of the 2018 ICE Exchange. The format will include both presentations and panel discussions, and will be interactive, allowing the audience to observe, comment and ask questions. Presenters will be respected researchers and /or representatives of organizations that have introduced novel approaches to recertification or revalidation, supported by research or theory.

- **Objectives Include:**

- Review why quality continuing competence programs are important
- Explore how certification and credentialing are under legislative attack
- Learn how various organizations are responding to these issues
- Review the need to make the case for quality certification/credentialing procedures
- Review/Discuss recent research supporting the value of certification and various Continuing Competence Initiatives
- Examine what research tells us about new and effective practices for improving adult learning, practitioner competence, or practice outcomes
- Explore ways in which risk can be incorporated into regulatory schemes to more proportionately regulate professionals on an initial and ongoing basis
- Examine issues surrounding recertifying general practice that may include specialty or sub-specialty practice
- Consider how learning can be incorporated into a recertification assessment process
- Evaluate regulators' experience using voluntary or mandatory assessment to target learning or professional development
- Look into ways Reflective Practice and Portfolios have been incorporated into revalidation or recertification schemes
- Review the success of incorporating competencies into a recertification process

- **Proceedings:** The Summit will be recorded and converted into written proceedings. These will be distributed to Summit participants as part of the value of the Summit. The Proceedings may also be made available for sale and online delivery from the ICE website.
